### SHRIVES OF SPAIN May 7th-19th 2026



#### THURSDAY, MAY 7th - DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight to Lisbon.

#### FRIDAY, MAY 8 – ARRIVE IN LISBON, PORTUGAL

Arrive in the Portuguese capital and check into your hotel. This evening, meet your Tour Director and fellow pilgrims. Dinner

#### SATURDAY, MAY 9 – LISBON TO FÁTIMA

Tour LISBON, including stops at Belém Tower, the Cathedral La Sé, and St. Anthony's Church. Visit the Church of St. Mary of Belém. Travel north to FÁTIMA and visit the Tomb of the Visionaries and the Chapel of Apparitions. Join the Rosary and candlelight procession at the Basilica. *Breakfast, Dinner* 

#### SUNDAY, MAY 10 – FÁTIMA

Free day at the Sanctuary. Optional excursion to Tomar to visit the Templar-built Convent of Christ. Mass at the Sanctuary and another opportunity to participate in the Rosary. *Breakfast, Dinner* 

#### MONDAY, MAY 11 – FÁTIMA TO BRAGA & SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Visit Bom Jesus do Monte in BRAGA, known for its unique zigzag stairway symbolizing the five senses and theological virtues. Continue to SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA and enjoy an orientation walk in the Old Town. Attend the Pilgrim Mass. *Breakfast*, *Dinner* 

#### TUESDAY, MAY 12 – SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Free time or an optional full-day excursion to Cape Finisterre and Galician fishing villages with a local lunch. That afternoon explore the historic Camino de Santiago route. *Breakfast* 

#### WEDNESDAY, MAY 13 – SANTIAGO TO BURGOS

Travel to the historic capital of Old Castile. Visit the majestic Burgos Cathedral—burial site of El Cid. Breakfast

#### THURSDAY, MAY 14 - BURGOS TO LOYOLA & LOURDES

Stop at the Sanctuary of Loyola, birthplace of St. Ignatius. Cross into France and arrive in Lourdes. Join pilgrims in the evening for the Rosary and candlelight procession. *Breakfast*, *Dinner* 

#### FRIDAY, MAY 15 – LOURDES

Guided tour of the Marian Shrine. Learn about St. Bernadette's visions of the Virgin Mary. Attend Mass and explore the market town at your own pace. *Breakfast* 

#### SATURDAY, MAY 16 – LOURDES TO MANRESA & MONTSERRAT

Journey across the border to Spain. Stop in Manresa to visit sites related to St. Ignatius of Loyola. Continue to Montserrat and spend the night near the Monastery. *Breakfast, Dinner* 

#### SUNDAY, MAY 17 – MONTSERRAT TO BARCELONA

Visit the Sanctuary and see the Black Madonna. Continue through Catalonia's wine region en route to vibrant Barcelona. Breakfast

#### MONDAY, MAY 18 - BARCELONA

Panoramic city tour including Montjuïc, Plaza Catalunya, Gaudí's Casa Batlló, Casa Milà, and the awe-inspiring Sagrada Familia. Enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. *Breakfast, Dinner* 

#### TUESDAY, MAY 19 – BARCELONA

Your pilgrimage concludes today with breakfast and heartfelt goodbyes. Breakfast
